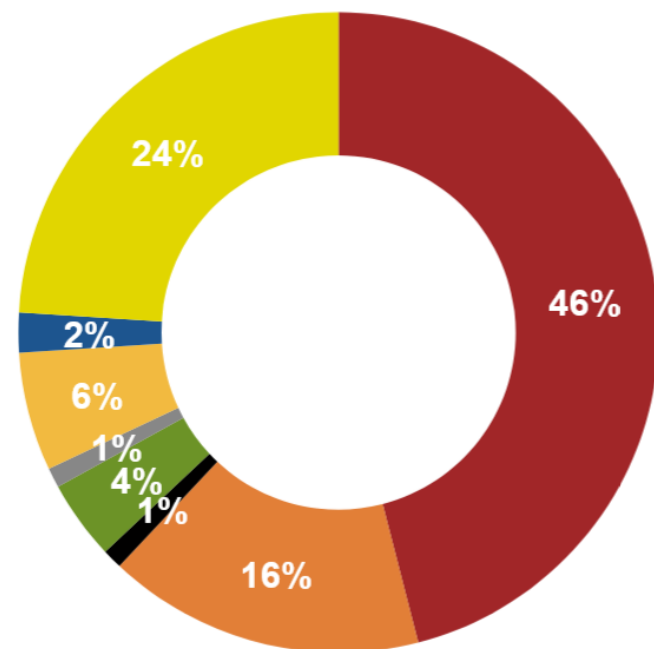

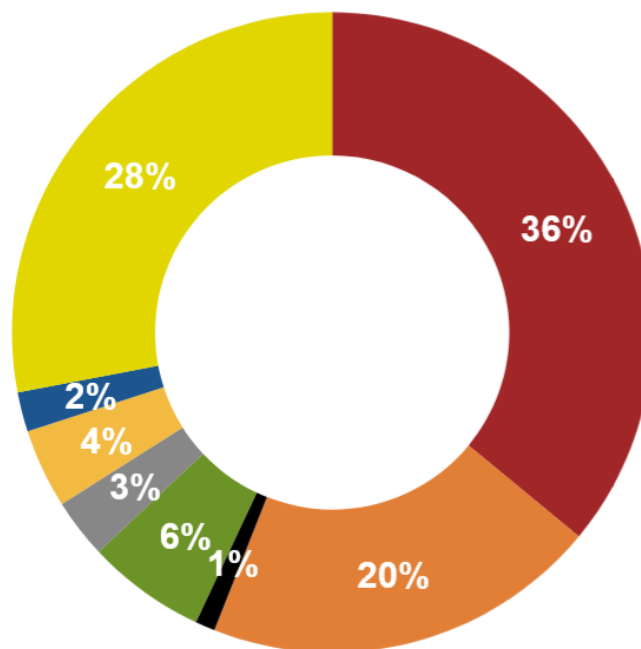

Selected Highlights: Mortality from different causes



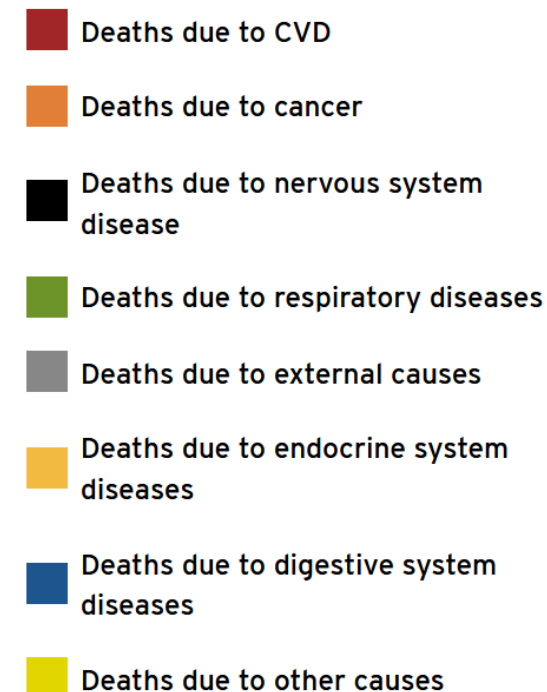
Women

(Number of deaths: 23,040)

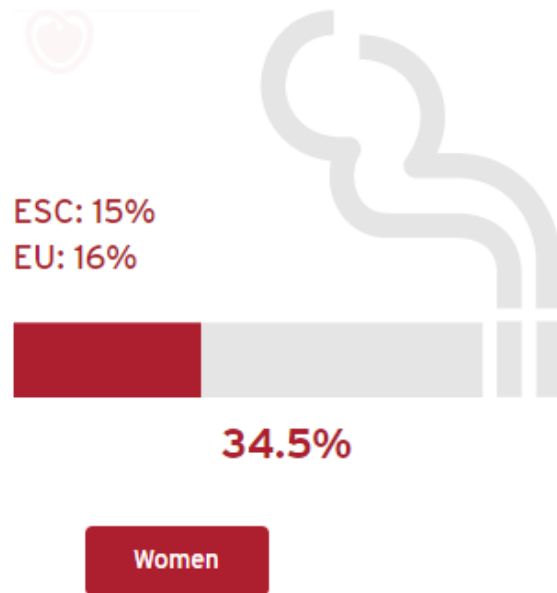

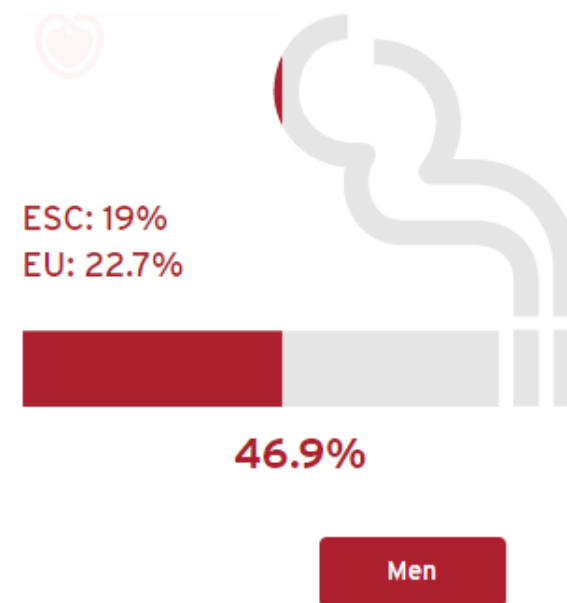

Selected Highlights: Risk Factors – Smoking Prevalence

The male population in Bosnia & Herzegovina has the higher % of daily smokers as ESC member countries, a median of **46.9%**. Smoking is a major risk factor for cardiovascular disease.

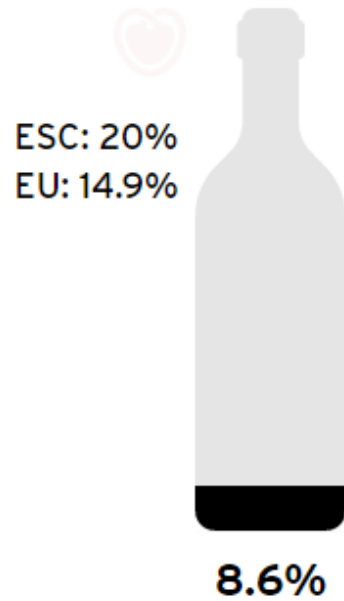

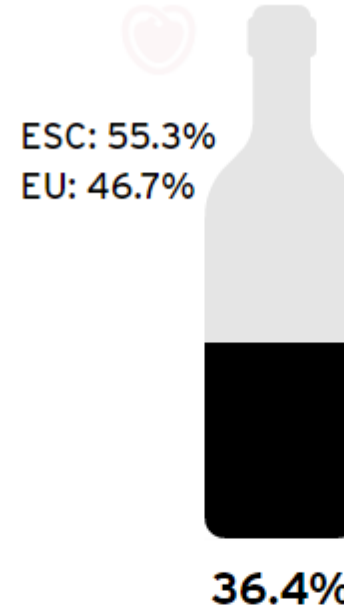

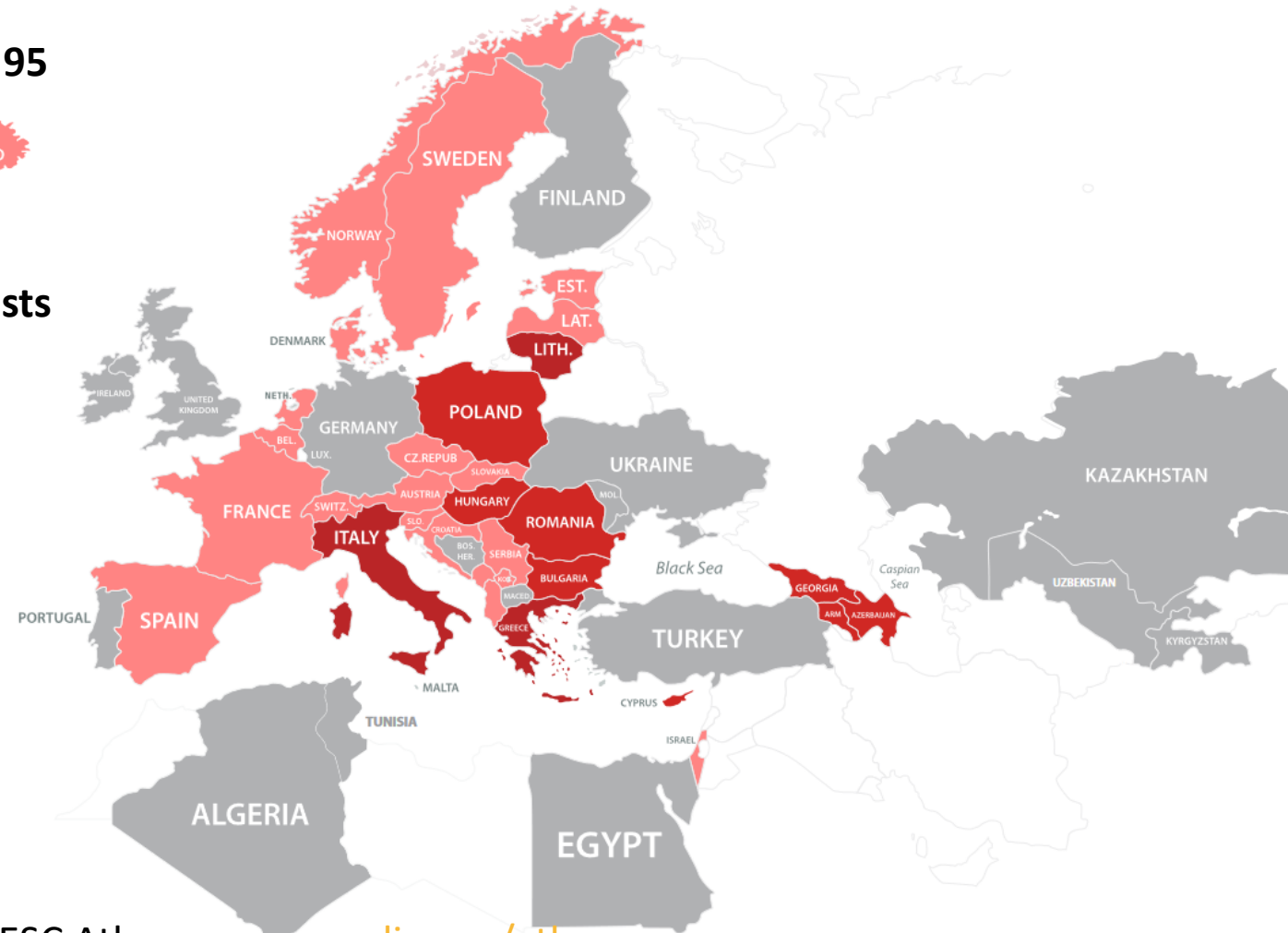

Across ESC member countries, there is a median of **95** cardiologists per million people.

In Bosnia & Herzegovina, the number of cardiologists is **41** per million.

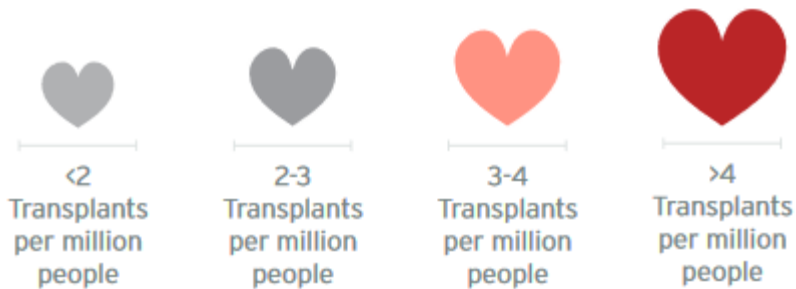
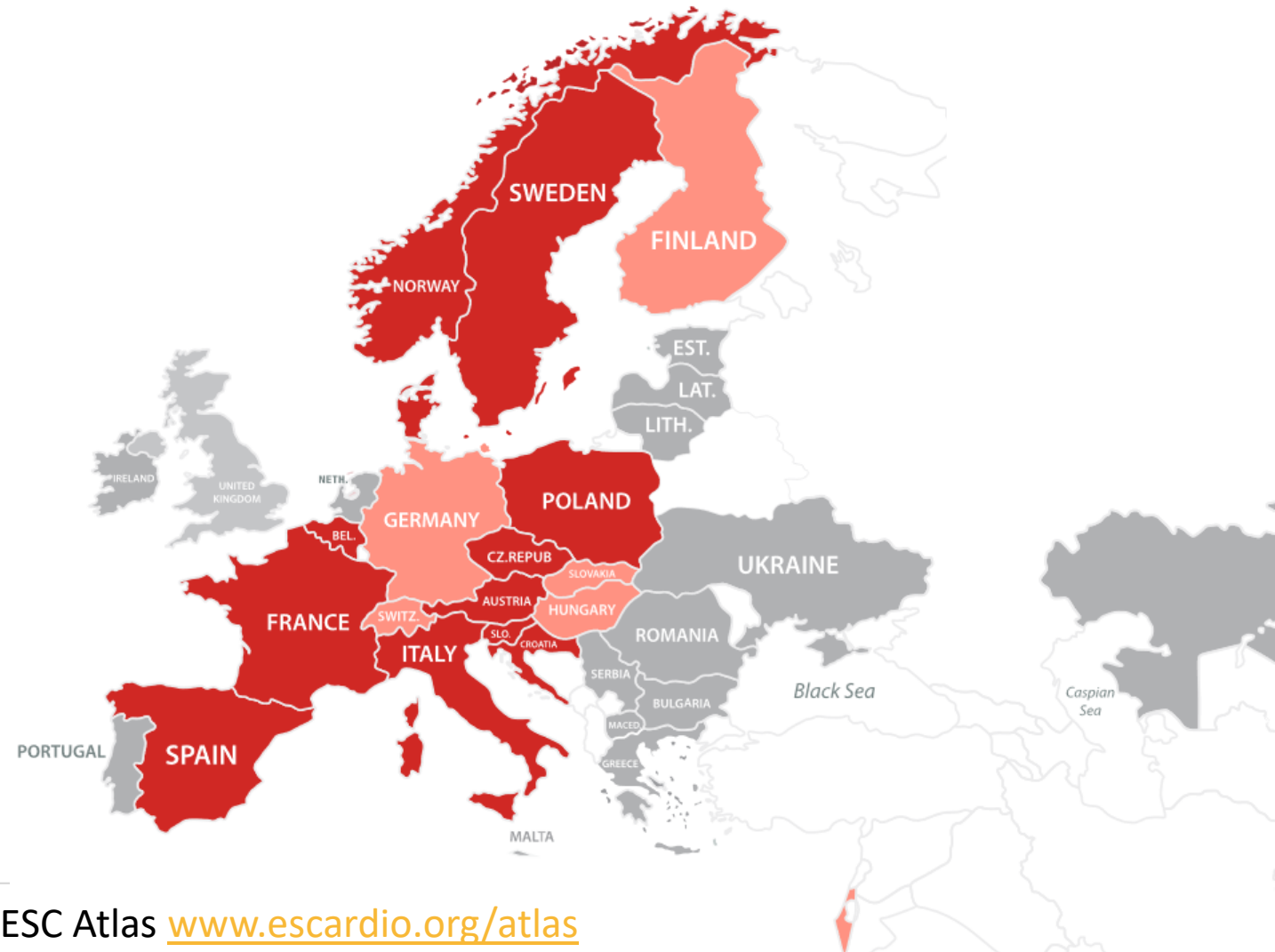
