




### Women

(Number of deaths: 136,245)



Healthcare	1,985 (31%)
Social care	234 (4%)
Informal care	2,806 (44%)
Morbidity losses	180 (3%)
Mortality losses	1,216 (19%)
<b>Total</b>	<b>€ 6,421</b>


# Selected Highlights: Risk Factors – Smoking Prevalence

The male population in Romania has the higher % of daily smokers as EU member countries, a median of 37.4%. Smoking is a major risk factor for cardiovascular disease.





In Romania, the number of cardiologists is **128** per million people.



